

Characters of trees 7 - Larch

Harmony and transformation

I conclude the series of drops on the theme of Tree Characters with larch, the embodied fusion of an inseparable creative couple and the two faces of the Source.

Larch fascinates me with its enigmatic nature, because it cannot be categorized, just like fungi, which are neither animals nor plants, or ivy and laurel, which are evergreen deciduous trees, larch also transcends known categorization. If you visit a larch tree in autumn and have not yet chatted with it, it will seem dry or dying with its golden yellow. But the tree is very much alive. All spring and summer, the larch walks with conifers, but in the fall it says goodbye to them and sheds its needles like deciduous trees. In the spring, new needles are the first to color the forest bright green. Then it turns into ocher and light brown, until in the autumn it shines again into a bronze yellow that highlights the forest landscape. It is a tree of many faces that enlivens summer greenery with maple and red pine.

Discarded larch needles merge with the soil under the snow and soon you won't find them anywhere. They are so gently embodied in Life that they resemble a fluffy dandelion light, which immediately, after touching the ground, transforms into a soil. Larch is a kind of plant chameleon and a mysterious connector of two different plant energies. In a truly wonderful way, it is a deciduous tree and a conifer at the same time, although the characteristics of one and the other are mutually exclusive.

It is internalized, like conifers, which do not change their appearance through the seasons, seeming to be unmoved by environmental stress and to flow their internal juices unhindered throughout the year. Also, larch generally has a slender frame like spruce, fir, yew or cedar, and when dressed in summer greenery, it could easily be overlooked among other conifers. It also has a rough and scaly trunk like some types of pine, but its needles are delicate and soft, hanging from the branches in fluffy tufts, unlike other conifers, which have needles as hard as knives.

But the larch turns away from conifers here and identifies with deciduous trees, which shed their leaves before winter and hibernate. The larch also sheds its soft needle-like leaves and thus, in the company of other conifers, creates a window through which light penetrates to the undergrowth and illuminates the darkness of winter. He acts almost sacrilegiously towards everyone who is lower.



Larch has a low shade tolerance and needles only grow where there is an abundance of light. When it is dressed, it gives the impression of a touching woody tenderness, but when undressed, it gives the impression of a ruthless penetration, from which you cannot hide.

Do you often fluctuate in mood, even several times a day and know how to draw different inspirations from different moods? Do you know how to turn a bad mood into a reason to visit nature and skilfully get out of low energy? Do you keep your 'soft' spots out of reach of people safe in the light of your attention? Do you often seem hard-hearted on the outside, but a closer look reveals your inner softness? Can you throw away old burdens, thoughts and memories once and for all and clean yourself of the traces of the past? Do you draw inspiration from your own heart rather than look to 'established practice'? Then you are undeniably a larch man.

If you need a boost for a new beginning or want to express your inner beauty, then find shelter where these tall and gentle trees support you with the unique power of sheding, transformation and new inspirations. More than anything else, larch harmonizes you energetically and ignites a creative charge in you.

The word transformation makes us think that something is created from something, for example, a butterfly from bug or an ant from larva, that this is an event. Therefore, it is better to say transformationing, and by that to understand a continuous process known as Life. Where there is no continuous transformationing, there is no Life.

Humans are right now in the process of setting in motion the Movement of Life or riding Its current. If until now we have been hibernating in the darkness of the Earth and preparing for germination, now we are awakening the life juices and joining the Flow of Life.

Of course, even as a seed buried underground, we are not completely dead, we are just sleeping and waiting for favorable conditions, but if we delay, we can rot. Now the conditions to bloom are here! Now is the time to outgrow the body and begin to perceive ourselves as a spirit, as Light, this is the time of transillumination of the body and spiritual birth.

Every birth is a union of Womb and Seed, Love and Light. Love is a limitless and unsurpassed creative force without competition. It is the core of the Creator's nature, the feminine aspect of the creative couple or the universal Womb. Love is a kind of metaphysical gravity that pulls, binds, connects everything into Oneness.



Whereas Light is the physical manifestation of creation... the only thing that exists..., and the means of self-knowledge and awareness without which Love could not express itself. It is the male aspect of the creative duo. Light is the embodiment of Love, and Love inspires Light, and they cannot be separated. Together, create an illusion or reflection of Themselves, as a projector, project images onto the canvas of Life, which is known as creation or the material world. The Light is wise, it illuminates the confusion of darkness into clarity of understanding.

The dance of Love and Light is the same, whatever you observe, be it a microscopic phenomenon, yourself, a tree or a galaxy. But if their dance in the oak is represented as immovable firmness and in the maple as a delicate sensitivity, through the larch they pour out as harmony and mutual balance. The larch really charmingly enacts the equal union of Love and Light, it is a living display of the highest form of LoveMaking.

We would be wronging their other children, if we did not see their LoveMaking in every organic thing, which has inspired poets and bards and other sentient lovers since the dawn of time, who do not love each other with bodies, but with <u>loving rays of attention</u>.

<u>Loving attention</u> is the highest expression of the union of Love and Light, it is an expression of <u>realized self-knowing</u>. Love and Light are the pull and push of energy that, when balanced, create harmony, order, health, beauty..., when broken, they create confusion, disorder, sickness, ugliness... . There is no creation that does not have the presence of the two creative elements, because in this case it would not exist, their balance can only be broken and create greater or lesser distortions.

The fusion of Love/Light is an enabler, it is a giver of energy, when Light is enraptured by Love, so you balance them in yourself when you live your loves.

I have often wondered if a child who is interested in cars, computers, programming... is the realization of love? Unfortunately, actually fortunately, it isn't. It is something inherited from the environment, it is valued and probably financially profitable, but it is not an inspiration of love. You can recognize it by the uniqueness, characteristic only of this child, and his works caress the soul, not the intellect, which can only be said about a computer program by a software enthusiast who understands the mental complexity of the program, or about a new car design only by a kindred intellect who sees beauty in it.



Neither one nor the other would move me, I would only see a destroyed Life in it. You best recognize Life's origin and loving inspiration through multiplication; 'What would happen if a lot of people followed this?' and you would get the answer of increasing or destroying Life. Love/Wisdom cannot inspire the latter because Creation is their nature. Creation, on the other hand, is understood by the mind as the making the Living into a dead thing and is the opposite of creation. Wondering what would you do then if you didn't destroy? I am happy for you, with this interest you are already on your way to finding the answer.

But the point of embodying souls has nothing to do with conquering, possessing, transforming, and selling any thing that is there to support your thing-body and to inspire you, so that your wholeness may progress toward ever-increasing purification or crystallizing of the personal energy of all distortions, which arise when you implement unloving initiatives, i.e. ideas taken from the outside. Crystallization of the soul is present at all seven levels of light densities of maturing souls (more on this in the Law of Life), until it reaches complete fusion with Source.

The balance in you is the equalization of Love and Wisdom. Energy blockages cause thoughts and perceptions that lack self-love and the wisdom to revive that love. This blocks the energy in the heart and throat center, and does not allow creative power to flow.

To unblock the flow in these vortexes, recognize lack of self-love as a cause of blockage of the heart center and un-realization of self-love as the cause of blockage of the throat vortex and do the necessary work of healing.

If love is helpful and giving, wisdom is self-serving because it seeks understanding. This <u>giving internalization</u> is the key to health on all levels, to know yourself and to be able to live it. Larch will help you with this personal harmony of spirit. Due to the impossibility of categorizing the larch as a conifer, which is a tree of inner abundance and a more or less unchanged exterior, or a deciduous tree, which expresses itself rather outwardly, the larch embodies the energy of the perfect fusion of the two faces of the creative Force.

It is the only tree known to me, I think there is also a bald cypress, but I don't know it, which equally flows and transitions from pull to push and expresses this also with its appearance. The tendency of Love for Wisdom is evident in the larch with the iridescent spectrum of colors in which it is clothed throughout the year and surpasses all notions of the conifer, which keeps its greenness unchanged.



The desire of Wisdom for Love can be understood precisely by the shedding of needle-like leaves, which turns the energy of the tree inward.

If Love is the substance of all that exists, Light is the structure and order of existence. Let's see through both faces how you can use this to harmonize your personal energy and heal.

Approach of Love

The feminine approach balances the energy with Love by identifying with the root of the pain, or trauma, reliving it without resistance as a non-involved third person (recapitulation or reliving) and accepting it as a stage of maturation where you recognize the trauma as an unconscious that wants to light of your knowledge and thus to annihilation. Harmonizing with Love requires a meditative mind that does not serve you its own explanations when you relive it, and a detached observation of the trauma in which the energy is stuck. In this way, you can see in detail all the elements of resentment, fear and anger towards the perpetrators of the trauma and recognize your role in creating the negative experience. We are often born with an unpurified energy tangles and conscious knowing cannot present it to us, so Love comes from trust in Life's perfection, in which there are no mistakes, what happens to you and initiates healing through forgiveness.

Cleansing with Love is an intense but effective treatment method that can immediately remove long-term energy blockages and instantly heal your light body. It is like cutting with a katana those energy threads that your blaming has attached to other people.

Approach of Wisdom

A masculine approach to healing one's own shadows is the approach of Wisdom, it is the energy of Order. It breaks the illusion by shifting perception and understanding. When you realize the nature of the mind, you break your own identification and attachment to thought forms that do not allow you to take responsibility for your own situation and thus healing, Wisdom heals by neglecting the thoughts, which eventually leads you to inner silence and healing.

Both approaches internally transform you into increasing responsibility for yourself and a comprehensive internalization that does not scatter energy into areas, where you have no influence, be it other people, the past and future, or non-life mental forms. It would be difficult to draw a dividing line between them and isolate them completely, you may be inclined to one more than the dear, but both are always present.



The most beautiful thing about this energy work is that your effort is needed to maintain energy in areas where it naturally has no place and, once freed, it calms down on its own in a natural position of complete presence to the present happening, in which Life is. It is a point of complete relaxation and pure satisfaction.

So when you humbly accept yourself, when you allow yourself to be nailed to the cross as pride that judges, blames others, and takes pity as a sacrificial victim, who cannot reproach himself for sin, self-love and the Wisdom of realizing this Love, will once again act like skilled dancers.

An example of the feminine principle of healing can be found in Jesus, who healed by forgiving and serving others, and an example of the masculine principle in Buddha, who healed by recognizing this world as an illusion and inviting to nurture inner silence. If you widen the field of observation, you recognize the same (un)balance between the culture of the West, which invites trust in God's will or the will of Life, and the East, which invites devotion with an understanding of the Law of Life.

The predominance of one side or the other in a person or a collective causes the incomprehensible distortions we know in the Inquisition and the spiritual narcissism of corrupt gurus. The success of one and the other was based on words that reflected the true knowledge of Life and gave the impression of Light origin, but did not have the power of realization. They spoke the truth, but their behavior was just the opposite. The inconsistency between speaking and acting created a conflict, which, sometime in the 70s, began to diminish and merge into a coherent unity. They were both partially right, while at the same time completely wrong.

This apparent conflict between Love and Wisdom is already losing its grip to this day. Now you understand that without Love your Life is meaningless and lost. You see the magnitude of the statement; 'Understand Love'?

This completely natural and imperceptible to the unobservant eye, union of a creative couple embodies every form of organic Life, but we can without exaggeration place larch at the very top of the embodiment of this magic. In vain is all your effort to understand the material structure of this world, to tire your mind in conquering the universe, to erect monuments to your arrogance, it is enough to understand Love and ignore everything else.



If you would like to love yourself and have the courage to realize your self-love, then find this miracle worker to balance the discord between your head and heart and end the conflict between them once and for all. Now you will be able to say no to the compromises you made with the devil and, albeit with the last drops of love, get out of the knots and irresistibly luxuriate in the newly unearthed inner beauties. If you haven't yet connected that Love is not something you have or don't have, know or don't know, but something you are or aren't, then larch will shatter that illusion for you as a joke.
