

Rise of the Unicorns

I am always moved when I come across a unique one in a galaxy of characters who cannot be imitated. Their unsociability is not intentional. At first, many Unicorns suffer an exclusion they did not choose, but later it becomes a silent influence that attracts imitation. Unicorns know the beauty of silence and are adept readers of the inner compass, which they faithfully follow. Independence of thought, moral courage and freedom from unhealthy emotions place them at the very top of spiritual giants.

In the forest, each tree embodies its own energy, which gives it character (See Characters of trees). One are tall and imposing, they immediately catch your eye because they dominate the landscape. Others support them with dense undergrowth, they are indispensable but easily overlooked. While you find the Unicorn tree among the soft shadows of the serenity of the forest, special and unique, with deep and strong roots that keep the balance in every storm. It remains invisible to those who observe superficially or from afar.

Unicorns' unique skill of introspection skills, spontaneous thoughts, and emotional stability make them fascinating and rare examples among today's characters. Although, due to their unruliness, they were long regarded as thorn in the heels to be pulled out, today we prefer to leave them in the heel to tease us to surpass ourselves. Despite giving the impression of Himalayan recluses, Unicorns are the ones who will be the first to notice a change in you, even the slightest shade of mood.

Openness isn't just about expressing yourself, it's about creating healthy boundaries for fruitful relationships based on trust and authenticity.



Flexibility

The unicorn feels good in the unknown, the routine reminds him of the spiritual inflexibility in which he is stuck. His ability to conquer the unknown does not negate the values to which he remains faithful, but instead absorbs newness in such a way that it expands the inner space into ever-increasing harmony with the Will of Life. His inner solidity is contagious, and his straightforwardness is certainly attractive if that's your thing, otherwise, of course, it bothers you like a light on in a den of unseemly secrets. The unicorn inspires with a characteristic aroma that rises from inner purity. Quite unlike those leaders who rely on position and power to assert their superiority over the weaker, the Unicorn inspires with compassion, understanding and genuine advocacy for the other's position to take courage and live the best of what they have.

Mysteriousness

The mysteriousness of the Unicorn not only protects against the loss of the creative Peace, it is also a strategy for choosing the words spoken and how he is experienced by others. People find his serenity pleasant and like to bathe in the calm confidence he exudes.

Then they feel the power behind the penetrating gaze and the enigmatic smile with which he silently answers their inquiries. A unicorn opens his heart to those who respect his personal space, time and freedom and are purely present, without hidden intentions. There isn no 'hero' who can fool the Unicorn. He doesn't like do-gooders

He realized that people's behavior is dictated by factors he doesn't know, so he has a higher tolerance and empathizes with others more easily. He sees beyond the obvious into layers that lie beneath the surface and influence people's actions of which they themselves know nothing. He knows that everyone is fighting their own battle with demons that they will face when they are ready. It leaves the pace of their maturation intact.

A unicorn keeps to himself and only makes sure that it doesn't get caught up in judging others. Due to his non-judgmental attitude, he is often a haven for wounded souls who feel accepted by him.
